**About the Workshop**

The Chicago Chapter of the ARS is delighted to announce that Anne Timberlake will direct our 2023 workshop.

Jack Kerouac called music “the only truth.” For composers, it's also bread and life– and sometimes muse. We'll get "meta" this workshop, exploring the surprisingly rich tradition of music about... music. Over hundreds of years and across a broad swatch of geography, Composers have crafted musical paeans to the glory of their art. We'll explore music about the power of music, the art of song, and even specific instruments, penned by a diverse array of Renaissance and Baroque composers including Ludwig Senfl, Henry Purcell, William Byrd, and Thomas Tompkins. In parallel, we'll explore the ways in which we, as players, become part of our own instruments, including the ramifications this has for our technique and musicianship.

Bring your instruments, music stand, pencil and enthusiasm!

**About the Conductor**

Anne Timberlake has appeared across the United States performing repertoire from Bach to twenty-first-century premieres. She holds degrees in recorder performance from Oberlin Conservatory and Indiana University, Critics have described her playing as "dazzling" (Chicago Classical Review) and "preternaturally persuasive" (The Ann Arbor Observer). A Fulbright grantee, Anne won Early Music America's 2011 Naxos Recording Competition with her ensemble Wayward Sisters. Anne enjoys teaching as well as playing, and is a regular instructor at workshops coast to coast.

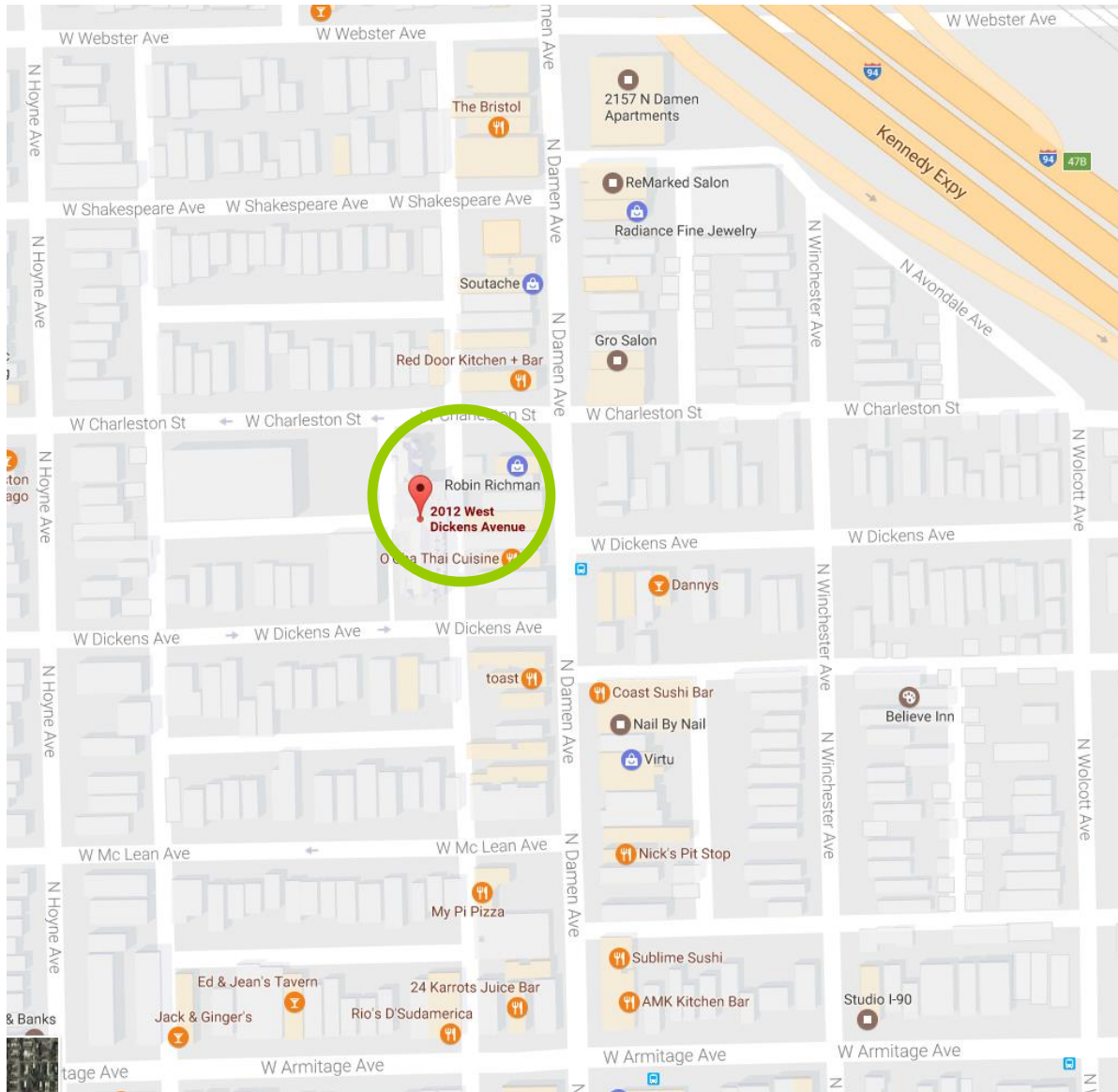

## Directions to Covenant Presbyterian Church

Covenant Presbyterian is the regular meeting place for the Chicago chapter of the American Recorder Society. It is at 2012 West Dickens in the Bucktown neighborhood of Chicago, near Damen & Armitage and near exit 47 on the Kennedy expressway. Street parking is available, and a lot behind the church on Charleston may have spaces. The church is also easily accessible by public transportation. Take the Blue line elevated train to either Damen or Western Avenue and walk ([www.transitchicago.com](http://www.transitchicago.com)), or take either the #49 Western Avenue Bus or the #50 Damen Avenue bus. The church is also near the Clybourn stop on the Metra Union Pacific North and North West train lines ([www.metrarail.com](http://www.metrarail.com)).
